

Set-Up Requirements

- We will send out assigned vendor space(s) 3 days before Cherry Fair day.
- Assigned spaces and space numbers are painted on the ground by noon the day before Cherry Fair.
- If you are able, please set up what you can the night before.*
- Approved entrances and exits:
 - Next to Founders Hall near the corner of Hwy 237 and Church Street.
 - Cove Sportsman Club on Hwy 237 west of Ascension School.
- The area between Founders Hall and the camper cabin is closed to all vehicle traffic.
- Cherry Fair volunteers will be available to help with space locations.
- Driving on the fairgrounds and in vendor areas is prohibited from 8am to 4pm on fair day.
- Vendor parking areas are limited to one (1) vehicle per vendor. Approved parking areas:
 - Lawn behind camper cabins on the south property line along Hwy 237.
 - Cove Sportsman Club west of the fairgrounds.
- Do not obstruct areas marked "no parking" as they are required for fire and emergency uses.
- Prepare to stay open until 4pm.

Tips for Success

- Sign up early to get the best spaces and best chance for having special requests met.
- Keep a copy of your Vendor/Venue Information and Registration Form.
- Do a practice set-up run at home to make sure you have all the equipment and supplies you need to be productive and comfortable for a full 8-hour day.
- Bring a canopy to keep yourself and your goods cool and comfy. Natural shade is limited.
- Bring a chair. Eight hours is a full day, and your feet and knees need a break now and then.
- Bring your own power strip, long extension cord, or hose if you need power or water.
- Keep your products and the vendor area clean. Consider bringing a small waste basket, and wet wipes or paper towels.
- You may leave your things overnight if you set up on Friday. Protect your products from the weather and make sure your belongings are reasonably secure.*
- Bring plenty of extra change. We have no banks in Cove, and only one cash machine at *Steakhouse at Cove* on the 21-and-over side.
- Accept multiple types of currency (cash, check, and credit/debit) if possible.
- Make sure there is someone available to cover your space when you take a break.
- Most important: Have fun with a lot of great people!**
